St. Augustine, Ponte Vedra & The Beaches has more than 7,000 accommodation units. From world-famous luxurious seaside resorts to historic bed & breakfast inns. There's something here for everyone's taste.

Ponte Vedra Beach's resorts are known worldwide for their luxurious accommodations and superb recreation facilities.

The AAA Five-Diamond Ponte Vedra Inn & Club has been setting the standard for oceanfront resorts for many years. In November 2006, the Inn & Club opened their new deluxe Spa with 30,000 square-feet of elegant space, 22 treatment rooms, a lavish salon, and many new special features.
